Sermon Series Questions:

- 1. What did God reveal to you?
- 2. What are you going to do about it?
- 3. What is one element of God's character you learned?

Specific Questions:

- 1. For the majority of the Sermon Discussion Guide, this week we are going to provide prompts that can help create space for you to share your story. Dr. Dick Foth says, "God uses peoples' stories to tell His story, and He uses other peoples' stories to inform ours." Spend some time during this week's small group sharing each other's stories.
- 2. Have you ever been afraid to tell your story? Why?
- 3. What are some parts of your story that make your story unique?
- 4. Where do you see God's fingerprint in your life story?
- 5. What are some ways you can practice sharing your story and listening to others' stories?
