This weekend we talked about what it means to be known in community. These questions provide a framework to prompt or foster discussion. Don't feel you have to use all or any of these questions and you don't have to make it to the end! Use the questions that best fit your group and let discussion flow.

Sermon Series Questions:

- 1. What did God reveal to you?
- 2. What are you going to do about it?
- 3. What is one element of God's character you learned?

Specific Questions:

- 1. John 1:14 says, "The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us." What comfort zone do you need to move out of in order to bring the Gospel to others?
- 2. There is a difference between being "around" and being "with" people. One is more intentional. Being with people helps you grow. What friendships are you pursuing with people who are in different seasons and stages than you?
- 3. Pastor Joel says, "It is not NCC that impacts our community- it is the NCCers who impact our community." How is our church known in community? What are you known for in your community?
- 4. Who in your life, outside your faith community, has challenged your faith and helped you grow? How did you grow? What did you learn?
- 5. How can you show the love of God to someone in your community this week?
