How are you living out what you're learning from the book of Daniel in your life right now?

Message Overview

Living UNSHAKEN is refusing to compromise your convictions, even if it costs you a fiery furnace or lands you in a lion's den. It's speaking truth to power. It's showing grace in a cancel culture. It's confronting the brutal facts with unwavering faith. Why? God's got this. God's got you. Don't lose faith in the end of the story! Administrations come and go. Nations and rise and fall. The kingdom of God is forever. We find our identity, we pledge our loyalty, to the King and His Kingdom. And He's coming again!

Message-Specific Discussion Questions

As we dive into Daniel 12, what were you taught about the end times? How do you view the end of the God's story?

Pastor Mark shares the story of the siege of Sarajevo in 1992 and a cellist named *Vedran Smailovic*. At such a chaotic moment in history, he didn't know what else to do but play his

cello. In Vedran's own words, **"My weapon is my cello."** You may not be a cello player, but God has given you a gift. **What gift(s) are you anchoring to in this season?**

Sara Groves says, "It is easy to stand around a bombed-out crater and talk about the crater—how it got there, who's to blame for it, and all its particulars. It is much harder to step past the edge of it, down into the middle of it, and say or make or do something generative." How are you speaking life over the "craters" that exist in our world today? What do you believe your role is in standing in the gap?
