Philippians 2:12-13

What does it mean to work out your salvation?

It does not say <u>work FOR</u> your salvation. It is about working OUT what God is <u>working IN</u> to your life.

It's not about EARNING your salvation. It is about EXERCISING your salvation. Putting your salvation on display. Letting the world see the work that God is doing inside of you.

Following Jesus means committing to a lifelong journey of:

- being a student of the WORDS of Jesus
- being an imitator of the WAYS of Jesus.
- partnering in the MISSION of Jesus.

Following Jesus means we learn to live our lives FROM Jesus.

What does it mean to fear God?

Fearing God means that <u>we reverence God</u> and <u>we reference God</u> in all that we say and do.

Reverencing God = recognize, acknowledge, honor who He is.

Referencing God = seek Him, trust Him, obey Him because He is our compass.

What does trembling mean? (work out your salvation with fear and trembling.)

Psalm 2:11

Trembling has less to do with dread and dismay, and more to do with excitement and anticipation!

Philippians 2:14-16 - Shine like stars in the universe

Genesis 1 - In the beginning God said let there be light.

Daniel 12:3

When you know that God's got you, you can SHINE!

<u>Matthew 5:15-16</u> - let your light shine before men; that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

YOUR MISSION - to shine brightly in your generation.

As we work out what Jesus is working in us, we reflect His character more perfectly, we proclaim His message more boldly, and we give a brighter vision of God and who He is to the world around us. -Pastor Heather Zempel
